The current water charge per 665 cubic feet is \$34.79, with the City of Chicago increase of .82% it will bring the new charge for 665 cubic feet to \$35.08. So the minimum bill for water and sewer will now be \$59.46 per month.
You will see this increase on the July bill, due in August which is for June usage.
